<u>As we gather</u>

Both the creation and the fostering of faith are the work of God alone. The ministers of the congregation at Corinth had sown the word of God. However, the people had not grown and advanced beyond spiritual infancy the way they should have. They thought they were very knowledgeable because they valued and looked for human wisdom and critically drew off favourites according to their ministers' particular styles. Paul told them they were functioning according to their lower sinful natures. They needed to see themselves as God's field, God's building.
