In order to help you celebrate at this time, I have made a short list of ways that might help your worship experience. So, as you begin this time of celebration here are a few considerations might like to make, to

- Take some time to prepare a worship space, set up an altar area with a tablecloth, cross, Bible and candles.

- · As you begin your worship light the candles.
- · At the end of Maundy Thursday worship, strip down your altar and spend time reflecting in silence.
- · On Good Friday, set the cross on your altar and cover it with a black cloth. At the end of worship spend time reflecting in silence.
- On Easter Sunday, replace all the items on your altar and add an extra candle in the centre of your altar to serve as the Paschal Candle. Lay a white cloth at the base of the cross.
- · After you have finished your worship, perhaps take some time to get in contact with some of our members of the congregation and fellowship either online, by phone or in some other way to celebrate our risen Lord.
