

HENTY LUTHERAN PARISH 3rd Sunday of Easter 26th April 2020 #16



In the gospel reading this week Jesus makes himself known to the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed and broke it and gave it to them. And their eyes were opened, and they recognized him ... Then the two told what had happened on the way, and how Jesus was recognized by them when he broke the bread (Luke 24:30-31, 35).

Throughout the New Testament letters, we hear that the followers devoted themselves to the breaking of bread.

In this phrase we are reminded to think back to the words Jesus spoke on Maundy Thursday as they were gathered in the upper room. Jesus took bread, and after blessing it broke it and gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is my body." And he took a cup, and when he had given thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink of it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins (Matt 26:26–28).

These words sound familiar to us, don't they? Through them He continually makes Himself known to us, He communicates His means of grace and he offers hope through them.

As St. Peter says, for you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect (1 Pe 1:18–19)
