As you are aware we are now able to gather for worship with up to 50 people. **This week we will be reopening the churches in Culcairn and Pleasant Hills for worship. Due to the size of the church buildings Culcairn will only be able to host 25 people (including those necessary to conduct worship), and 15 in Pleasant Hills.** At present there will be no communion.

In order to do this we do ask for your help.

For your safety and the safety of others please follow the guidelines set out below:

- If you are not well please stay home.
- Practice good hygiene, wash hands / use sanitiser etc.
- Please refrain from unnecessary touching of furniture
- Please physically distance yourselves from others (1.5m).
- Bring your own pen & sign the register when arriving and leaving
- Follow all reasonable requests given by the ushers.
- Only worship in your own congregation.

If you don't feel comfortable coming back to services yet that's fine, there's no pressure. We will continue to provide the worship literature and Facebook sermons as we have been doing.

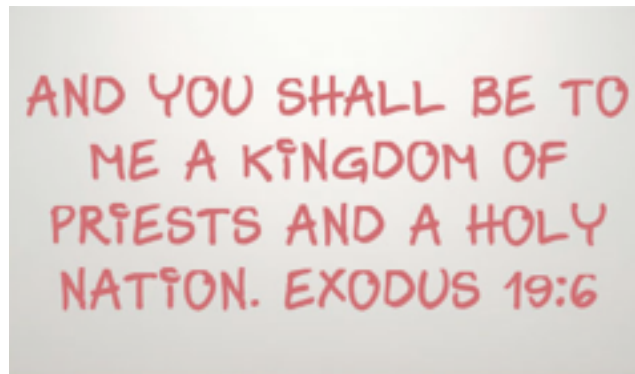
