Confession and Declaration of Grace

We pray for all who have been baptised in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, as they witness to your love and action in the world. We pray for all parents who teach the true faith to their baptised children. Lord, bless these families for generations to come.

Lord God, you are the ground of our existence and the foundation of our faith. Support us in this faith as we live in your name, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
