Matthew 13:1-9,18-23: Not only is the word of God to be 'heard', but it is to be heard with a heart which is open to its truth and gladly receives what it clearly says without rejection. Wherever people hear the word of God itself with 'good and honest hearts', taught in its clear and simple truth, there will always be a harvest. Wherever intellectual sophistication, shallow reception, material riches or cares and worries of life come first, the word (like the seed) is choked of its growth. Jesus told this parable in the climate of contemporary rejection (see vv 10-17), but meant its teaching for the benefit of the future church. To which category will we belong?
